Magazines
Newspapers
Old photos that can be glued onto a project
Internet images
Paper

Have family members (all ages) draw their face or even a stick figure of themselves. Then have them make a "thinking" bubble above the head area of their drawing. Within the drawn "thinking bubble," have them collage what they are thinking about. This should spark some fun and interesting family discussion.
