If you do not have the ability to access our meeting on your computer, you can use your phone and call into the meeting, instead. To do so, follow these instructions:

1. Call (301) 715-8592
2. When prompted, type in the meeting room number: 813 2288 6237
3. When prompted, type in CtK's meeting passcode. (If you don't know what this is, contact Pastor Tim at pastortim@ctkdurango.org.)

We have learned some good practices over the past several months when using ZOOM for online meetings, especially when there are so many devices signed on at one time. Please help us out by following these guidelines:

- Please keep your microphone muted unless you have a comment, question or point of order. You can mute / unmute yourself by clicking on the microphone icon at the bottom right hand side of your computer screen.
- We will be conducting votes by a show of hands, so when it comes time to vote please be sure that your camera is turned on. (This is also controlled by an icon at the bottom right hand side of your computer screen.)
- To expedite the voting process, we will be asking for votes *against* a proposed motion *first*. This will be announced prior to each vote we take as a reminder.

We thank you in advance for your patience and forgiveness for any mistakes we may make. But, above all, we thank you for participating in this important event in the life and witness of this wonderful congregation.
