

RTLCL Summer 2022 COVID 19 Protocols for In Person Day Camps Updated: April 22, 2022.

Created as a living document and is subject to update if transmission levels increase and in accordance with CDC, ACA Field Guide, Local and State Public Health Authority current guidelines and recommendations.

1. All campers/volunteers/adult leaders/host families have read and will adhere to the RTLCL Day Camp Vaccination Policy.
2. All campers/volunteers and adult leaders will complete a brief prescreening of temperature and general health by RTLCL Staff each day upon arrival.
3. Masks are NOT required for indoor or outdoor activities, unless there is sustained direct contact and risk of respiratory transmission, and outdoor activities are strongly encouraged.
4. Congregations are asked to provide hand washing or hand sanitizer stations. They are also encouraged to promote increased ventilation indoors through the use of open windows and fans.
5. Individual servings of snacks or meals are preferable unless snacks/meals served by masked and gloved servers to participants also wearing masks if in line to receive.
6. All onsite RTLCL protocols will be followed as far as hand hygiene, masks, and distancing.
